Truth Claims | September 6, 2017

Worldview – a collection of beliefs about life and the universe held by an individual or a group; perspective from which one sees and interprets the world; the basis for your moral decision making.

A Worldview Answers: origin identity
meaning morality destiny

What does a valid worldview look like?

1. Must make sense (Answers have to consistently work together)
2. Must be adequate (Deal truthfully and completely with all facts)
3. Must be relevant (Must make sense of the emotions and feelings I have as I interact with the world around me)

Building a Christian Worldview

1. Absolute truth exists
2. God exists (Genesis 1:1)
3. He has chosen to reveal Himself (Hebrews 1:1-2)
4. How did God reveal Himself?
 - Creation (Genesis 1:1)
 - Scripture (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21)
 - In human flesh (John 1:1-14; John 3:16)
5. Our mind is changed to be like the mind of Jesus (Romans 12:1-2)

Journey Group Questions

1. What is a worldview? Review the passages from the message (Genesis 1:1; Hebrews 1:1-2; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21; John 1:1-14; John 3:16; and Romans 12:1-2) How do these verses help as we build a strong, Christian worldview?

2. Why must it make sense and adequately address issues and facts?

3. Why is it important for a worldview to address origin, identity, meaning, morality, and destiny?

ORIGIN – How did life begin?

IDENTITY – What does it mean to be a human? Am I more important than animals?

MEANING – Why are we here? Why am I here?

DESTINY – What will happen to me after I die? Will I have to answer for the choices I made in this life?
