James 1:27, Psalm 146:9, Deuteronomy 10:18,
Matthew 8:1-4, James 2:14-16

Key Principle: God cares about the vulnerable.

1. Widows and orphans.

2. Sick and excluded.

3. Poor and desperate.

LIFT Question: Who are the outcasts in your life that people generally try avoiding? How would Jesus treat the outcasts in your life? What might He be calling you to do?

Journey Group Questions

1. Read James 1:27, Psalm 146:9, Deuteronomy 10:18, and Matthew 8:1-4. Who are the people groups that these passages reveal are cared for by God? What does that mean for the ways we ought to treat them?
2. Describe a time when you have felt compassion for someone who was in need. Did you help that person? If not, what prevented you? If you did help out that individual, how did you feel?
3. Talk about a time when you were in great need. Did someone help you out? How did that make you feel?
4. How has the Scripture we have discussed reshaped your view of God? What do you think God's compassion for the vulnerable means for us?
5. What can we do to live out God's mission to care for and stand up for the poor, the marginalized, and the outcasts? How does this shape our everyday lives?
