Reflection Questions

1. In 2 Kings 22:8, Hilkiah the High Priest finds the Book of the Law. This was a scroll with parts or all of the first 5 books of the Old Testament (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy). Obviously, he was pretty surprised by this. Most likely his surprise was because the Law of God had been ignored and forgotten for quite some time. How do you treat God's Word, the Bible? Is it something you regularly use, or regularly lose? Do you have a Bible you can read, or has it been a long time since you've read it? What might this say about how you are following God's desire for your life?

2. Once Josiah heard the Law, he realized the kingdom was not following it (2 Kings 22:11-13). What was his response? Was he ok with how things were, or did he repent? What was God's response to Josiah's actions and mindset? See 2 Kings 22:15-20.

3. After Josiah heard from the LORD, what did he do? What kind of leadership did he display in his actions and the way he used his reign? Look at 2 Kings 22:1-2 and 2 Kings 23.

4. What happened after Josiah's reign as king? Were the people faithful to God? Were the rulers faithful to God? See 2 Kings 23:31-37.
