Worship Together | Psalm 95 November 14, 2018

- 1. We worship together to praise God as the <u>rock of our salvation</u>.
- 2. We worship together to praise God as King.
- 3. We worship together to praise God as the <u>Creator</u>.
- 4. We worship together to remember God's <u>faithfulness</u>.

Journey Group Questions

1. Read Psalm 95. What are some differences between worshiping God together with other believers and worshipping God on your own?

2. What do the descriptions of worship as "joyfully" (verse 1), "triumphantly" (verse 1 & 2), and "with thanksgiving" (verse 2) tell us about an attitude of worship? How does this compare with your typical attitude when worshipping?

3. This Psalm is a call to worship God together and not to live like the Israelites had done in the wilderness (Remember Exodus 16-17 & Numbers 21). What are some modern worship songs that declare God's greatness as Creator, King, or Rock of salvation? Can you think of any modern worship songs that are calls to worship or warnings against rebellion?

4. In verses 7-11, the psalmist remembers the Israelites who had tested God to provide water for them. They did not trust Him to provide, and that generation did not get to enter into His "rest", the Promised Land. Read Hebrews 3:7-11. What might our rebellion look like in failing to worship God rightly? What is the "rest" we will not receive if we do not heed the words of the Holy Spirit?
