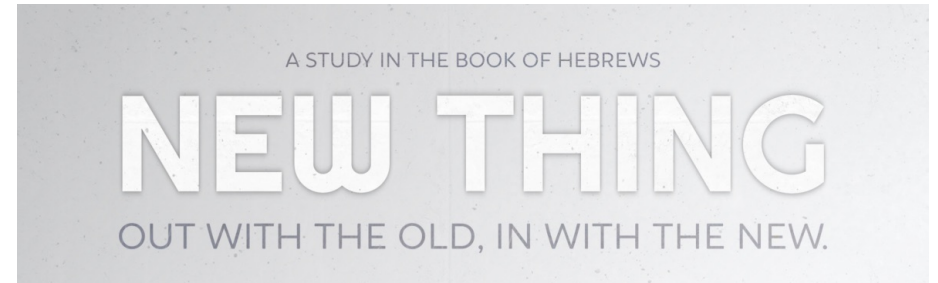

New Deliverer | Hebrews 1:4-3:7
January 9, 2019

Old: God delivered messages through angels.

New: God has perfectly expressed his message through His Son.

Old: God delivered his people through Moses.

New: God delivers his people through Christ.

Journey Group Questions

1. In Hebrews 1 and 2, Jesus is compared with angels and shown to be far superior to them. What is the difference between Jesus and an angel? (Look at Hebrews 1:4-14 and 2:5-11)

2. Angels were messengers, sent by God to deliver messages to people. In a far greater way, Jesus is sent to *be* the message to us. If you had to summarize the message of Christ's life to a few sentences, what would it be?

3. Why would Jesus become "lower than the angels"? Notice when this occurred and cross-reference to Philippians 2:1-11 to see the purpose of the humbling of Christ.

4. Read Hebrews 2:14-18. Why did Jesus have to suffer? From this passage, should we expect suffering in our lives as followers of Christ?

5. In Hebrews 3:1-6, Jesus is compared to Moses, one of the greatest leaders of the Old Testament. Moses is called "faithful in all God's house as a servant." Jesus is contrasted as "faithful over God's house as a son." Servants and sons had very different roles in the first century culture. While servants worked within the house, sons had authority over the house and under the authority of the father. In a similar way, Moses and Jesus hold these similar rolls. What is the house according to verse 6b?

6. What are some other similarities between Jesus and Moses? How does Jesus operate as a greater type of Moses?
