New Rest | Hebrews 3:7-4:12 January 16, 2019

- 1. Faith is shown in what we trust will save us.
- 2. Watch out for:
 - An unbelieving heart <u>falling away</u> (3:12)
 - A straying heart Looks like <u>apathy</u> (3:10)
 - A hardened heart Looks like <u>rebellion</u> (3:8)
- 3. Old: Israel rejected God's <u>authority</u> and <u>provision</u>
 New: Believers trust Christ's <u>authority</u> and <u>provision</u>
- 4. God's Word is <u>living and active</u>; it gets straight to the <u>heart</u>.

Journey Group Questions

1. Read Hebrews 3:7-14. Based on the message Wednesday, what are the differences between a hardened heart, a straying heart, and an unbelieving heart? Where do you tend to struggle in these categories?

4. Why should we observe the Sabbath? See Exodus 20 and Mark 2:27 for two reasons.

2. Can you recall times in your spiritual journey when you went through a period of apathy, disbelief, or rebellion? What was the reason for those feelings or decisions? How did your life during those times compare to periods when you follow closely to Christ? What do you think is the best course of action to avoid similar conditions in the future?

5. When do you set aside time to observe a Sabbath, or day of rest and worship, in your life? What needs to change in order for you to make the most of your Sabbath days?
