

## **Journey Group Questions**

1. Read Hebrews 13:1-3. The writer says in verse 1, "Let brotherly love continue." This love for one another is based on our relationship with each other in Christ as one family of faith. How can we relate to each other in ways that are loving like a family should love each other?

4. Throughout the world, there are many brothers and sisters in the faith who are imprisoned and/or persecuted heavily because of their faith in Jesus. How can you "Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body"?

2. Verse 2 talks about showing hospitality to strangers. What is hospitality? How can you deliberately show hospitality to strangers this week? Are there opportunities to show hospitality within our student ministry?

5. If you were in prison, how would you want to be loved by brothers and sisters in the faith? How can you love persecuted Christians in the same way today?
