Reflection Questions

1. What are some jobs that you might consider service focused? What's attractive about these jobs? What's unattractive about these jobs?

2. Read Jesus' example in John 13:1-5 and 12-15. How does Jesus want his disciples to treat each other according to his example?

3. Read verses 16 and 17. Jesus wants his disciples to understand that if they are truly to follow Him, they must learn to serve each other. How can you actively serve others this week when we gather together? Write down 3 examples.

4. Following Jesus' example is not just for when we meet together at the church. How can you serve at home? Write down 3 examples.

5. Finally, think about the other places you frequently interact with people. How can you be a servant there?
