4. Read Jesus' words in Matthew 5:14-16. Here, Jesus says "you are the light of the world." Who is he talking to here? How are they the light of the world if Jesus is the light of the world?
5. AM I: A light to my friends, family, and others? Do I point others to Jesus with my life or confuse others?
