

- Following Jesus is primarily about <u>faith</u>, not <u>works</u>.
- 2. Following Jesus primarily brings <u>eternal</u> life, not <u>physical</u> life.
- 3. Following Jesus is primarily about who you know, not what you get.

## The Bread of Life | John 6:25-58

January 15, 2020

As you read the Scriptures tonight, underline every time you see the phrase "I am" and circle every occurrence of the word "bread."

1. Read John 6:25-36. After Jesus fed the 5,000 men, he crosses the lake by walking on water in the night while his disciples sailed across. When they get to the other side, the people have followed them around. Why are these crowds still following Jesus according to these verses?

2. What are the works God desires for people to do? Look at verses 28-29. Which of our main points from Wednesday does this demonstrate?

3. Make a list of Jesus' claims about himself in verses 37-51. What does the crowd believe about Jesus?

4. Read verses 52-58. How did the crowd interpret what Jesus said? How should we interpret what he said and apply it in your life?

5. How can you remind yourself of Jesus' sustaining, life-giving power in your life?

6. How can you share with others that Jesus is the Bread of Life? Consider taking time to pray with your group before you begin discussion so that you do not run out of time at the end.
