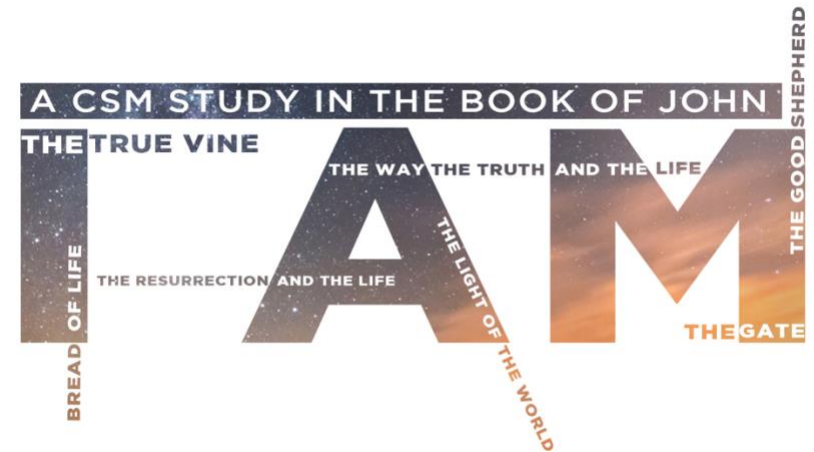

The Great I AM – Exodus 3:1-4

January 8, 2020

1. Read through Exodus 3:1-15. Notice how this amazing encounter with God begins in the middle of an average day of shepherding for Moses. What does your typical school day look like? What would you do if you saw a burning bush one day in your backyard or at school?
2. On Wednesday we saw how God reveals Himself, defines Himself, and names Himself in this passage. How is this different than our situation? Do we get to do these things for ourselves? If so, how?
3. Since God reveals, defines, and names Himself, how can we get to know Him? What things in our life can give us the wrong understanding of who God is?
4. How does Moses respond to God calling his name? What does this tell us about Moses? How would it feel to be in his situation?
5. How do you respond when you discover God is calling you to do something? When has God reassured you of His presence and power? How has God reminded you of your created purpose?
