

Key Principle: Jesus exercises power over <u>life</u> and

death.

- 1. Problem: We don't trust in Jesus.
- 2. Solution: Respond to the call.

## Raised to New Life | John 11:1-46

February 5, 2020

1. Review the story of Lazarus in John 11. Have someone summarize the story. Why did Jesus wait to go to Bethany (John 11:4 & 11:6)?

- 2. Imagine that you are Mary or Martha. You send word to Jesus that Lazarus is deathly sick. He waits to come to you and Lazarus dies.
- · How would you feel?
- · How does this look different than Martha's response in John 11:21-22?
- · How is this different than Mary's response in John 11:32?

3.How does Jesus respond to Lazarus' death and Mary's mourning in John 11:33-36? What does this reveal about who Jesus is and how you can trust him?

- 4. What does Jesus' miraculous work in John 11:39-44 reveal about his power?
- · What does this point to in the future regarding Jesus' own death?
- · What does it point to in the future regarding our future?

5. How does this story help you to rightly think about life and death? What is the proper response to Jesus (Look in verse 40)?
