


Save the date for Creed Camp, June 15-19!

The True Vine | John 15:1-11 February 19, 2020

- 1. Jesus calls his followers to abide in Him.
- 2. Jesus calls His followers to bear fruit.
- 3. Jesus calls his followers to <u>love</u> one another.

One + Two = Three
