



Who Am I? March 4, 2020

Romans 8

- Read Romans 8:1-11. What is condemnation (verse 1)? How is it that we are no longer condemned, but forgiven? (Also read John 3:16-18 for more on condemnation vs. forgiveness)
- 3. What kind of freedom do we have in Christ (verse 2)? Are we free from following the Law of Moses now or do we still have to keep it? Why or why not?

4. How does having the Spirit of God in us change the way we live? How does our mind think differently if we live by the Spirit rather than by the flesh (verses 5-8)?

2. What does it mean to be in Christ? How does this start? How does it continue?

5. What kind of life is Paul talking about will be given to our mortal bodies in verse 11? What kind of hope does this give us as we aspire to glorify God in our life?
